



Makeup Morgue

The Scenario: As a professional actor on the way to winning your first Tony Award, you have been cast in a role where you have to make yourself look like a wizened old man/woman. What should/could you look like on stage? Check into the morgue, your own makeup morgue, naturally!

A Makeup Morgue is a collection of pictures and photographs of examples to help you do your makeup accurately. All professional actors have one and makeup designers never leave home with it. As aspiring designers, you need to start one!

In your morgue you must include images of:

- 5 glamour women—think Marilyn and fashion models. Look back in time for old photographs and looks. Focus on their faces rather than their bodies...
- 5 old age examples of women—celebrities who have had tons of botox and peels will defeat your purpose as you need to really see those wrinkles. AND YOU WANT WRINKLES...
- 5 old age examples of men—wrinkles are mandatory!
- 10 stylized/fantasy examples—this is anything that catches your eye—Avatar, Halloween, fairy tales and goth. Fake noses, aliens and people transformed into animals will be central. Remember, we want faces.
- 5 grossies/gories examples—this consists of wounds, scars, black eyes, stitches, etc.
- 1 YouTube video of applying old age makeup; it can't be one I have shown you.
- 3 photos of you featuring shadows, shadows & highlights & your final
- 3 photos of your designs featuring shadows, shadows & highlights & your final

What should your morgue look like? Head out the great world of google and start your searches. You will mount your pages on google slides, which works just like Powerpoint. Make sure every slide has a title and every image is sourced. Please keep each group/category together and label them; you may put your categories in any order. Items not labeled and sourced will receive only less points...

How big should my pictures be? Of course, anything too small or too blurry will not help you. A perfect specimen is as large as your own hand and may be in black and white or in color. Absolutely no cartoons. Images are best at 400X400 and above are best.

Some final words of advice include

- Don't put more than three pictures on each slide
- Be consistent with font, font sizes, background and color choices
- Don't make audience wait for cutesy animations—your purpose is to get the information in such a manner that you could find it easily if you were doing makeup for an actor or presenting this at a makeup job interview
- You can put your images in any order, but keep all old age women together, all grossies or gories together, etc.
- Be prepared to present your favorite slide to the class...rubric to follow
